Adara, Calient present integrated SDN offering

Cloud software provider Adara Networks and Optical Circuit Switching (OCS) specialist Calient Technologies announced that they will be holding multiple live demonstrations of their SDN-TPOI (Transport Packet Optical Integration) offering at Open Networking Summit 2016 in Santa Clara, US from 14 to 17 March. The demonstrations will be presented in conjunction with ON.Lab, which leads the open source SDN ONOS (Open Network Operating System) initiative, and supported by network operators C-Spire, Centeris and China Unicom.

Launched in January, the Calient Adara SDN-TPOI offering combines SDN with advanced packet and optical networking technologies to build a real-time cloud computing and networking solution combining a low-latency, high-speed optical overlay network with existing layer 3 routed/IP-MPLS networks.
